

## Free School Meals / Pupil Premium

As of 1<sup>st</sup> September, **all EYFS and KS1** children are eligible for **free school meals**. If your child is in Reception Year 1 or 2 and is still having packed lunch... why??? Our school provides a hot meal for children eligible for this service. Please talk to the school office about taking up this fantastic offer.

# Are your family receiving any of these benefits?

- Income Support (IS)
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC), that does not exceed £16,190
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on-paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax
   Credit
- Universal Credit

### If so then

- your children could be eligible for free school meals
- the school will be given £935 per pupil in Pupil Premium Funding in order to help raise standards

If you think you qualify, please talk to the school office about applying for free school meals. This means a lot to us, as we will be awarded Pupil Premium Funding for 6 years for each pupil. And as a certain supermarket keeps on reminding us... "Every little helps."
